Recent cyber attacks have highlighted the need to more effectively manage third parties with access to an organization's data, including Business Associates and other vendors who assist employers in fulfilling their important function of providing benefits to employees and their families. This program focuses on how to establish a vendor management program to better safeguard employee benefits data through the use of the ERICCA Advisory Council's Cybersecurity Considerations for Benefit Plans.
